Group: Give us some. Don't be afraid.

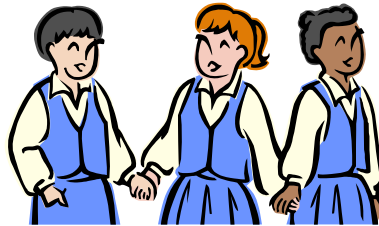
