Directions: Look at the picture. Say the word for that picture out loud. Tap it out to spell it by doing these steps:

- 1) Say the first sound in the word and touch your index finger to your thumb.

- 3) Say the last sound in the word and touch your ring finger to your thumb.
- 4) Tap one more time so that you hear all the sounds. Then write the letters for each sound. (If you can't remember all the letters, try writing as you tap.)

Remember: All of these words are C-V-C (consonant-vowel-consonant) words!



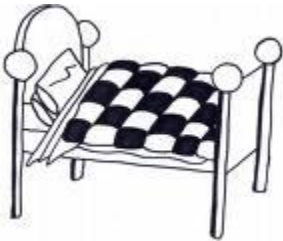

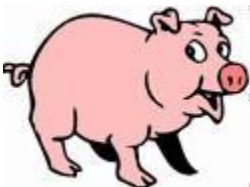
